Exam Analysis: CBSE class XII Business Studies paper was moderate but lengthy, say experts

The question paper was moderate and a few sections were tricky, writes Shruti Niraj



Business Studies examination conducted by CBSE on Thursday for the class XII commerce students got mixed response. The question paper was moderate and a few sections were tricky. Students claimed that questions based on case studies consumed a lot of time; hence many complained not being able to complete it on time.

Gurugram-based teacher Ekta Sharma told Education Times that the question paper was not too difficult, but few questions were tricky. "The paper was moderate. Some questions were tricky, especially in the case study section. The set 1 and 3 of the question paper were easier than the set 2," she said.

Gunjan Sethi, Business Studies teacher, Suncity School called it a balanced paper. "It was a balanced paper although few questions were framed in a manner that students found it difficult to understand." As compared to previous years, the question paper was slightly difficult, she added.

The students who have appeared in the examination felt that the paper was lengthy and they could not manage their time properly while answering them. The examination was based on NCERT syllabus, and there was nothing was spotted as out of prescribed course.

The class XII board examination 2019 will be concluded on April 3, 2019. Students are now preparing for the Mathematics examinations that is scheduled on March 18.
