The Student Council Elections were conducted during the month of July-August 2022. The enthusiastic students of Grades III and IV participated in the student council elections as candidates and/or voters. It was an attempt by the school to create awareness about the principles of democracy and to prepare our students to assume leadership roles.

The process of the Student Council Elections was divided into three stages. The first stage included the filing of nominations by students which was held in the respective classrooms on Wednesday, 6th July 2022.

<u>Self-nomination</u> was open for all students of Grades III & IV. Students were shortlisted on the basis of their interpersonal skills, logical thinking, critical and creative thinking and problem-solving abilities.











Later, the students prepared for their **campaign** to appeal for votes, as is done in all democracies. The students also prepared posters, promoting their candidature, which were displayed in the school premises. The future leaders of the school were also given an opportunity to visit different classes to personally introduce themselves and to seek votes. The campaigning process finally culminated on Monday, 11th July 2022, when the candidates made their main campaign speech in a special assembly in the school auditorium. It was such a memorable moment to witness the bright and confident students holding forth confidently and speak eloquently as to what they proposed to do should they be selected.





The campaign speeches were followed by **casting of votes** by all the students of Grade III and IV to support the candidate of their choice. The voting process was followed by **an interview** with **the Selection Board.** The candidates were interviewed by the honourable Head of School and a Panel of Teachers. The final selection was based upon the number of votes polled and the marks awarded by the selection committee in the interview.
